

5 Sample Questions

1. In *Beauty and the Beast*, what is Lumière's profession in the household?

Answer: Maître d' (head of staff / butler). He coordinates the dinner sequence of "Be Our Guest."

2. What's the name of Sebastian's pet/companion in *The Little Mermaid* (1989)?

Answer: Trick question — Sebastian is the king's appointed crab caretaker, not a pet owner. The fish friend is Flounder, who serves Ariel, not Sebastian.

3. In *Finding Nemo*, what's the address of P. Sherman, the dentist whose office is on the East Australian Current map?

Answer: 42 Wallaby Way, Sydney. Dory remembers it through repetition throughout the film.

4. What's the only Pixar feature film whose title is a single character's name?

*Answer: Several qualify (*Wall-E*, *Brave's* Merida, *Coco's* Miguel...) but the most precise answer is *Wall-E* (2008) — the entire title is the character's name with no other word.*

5. In *Frozen*, what does Anna's hair color reveal about her physical state?

Answer: Streaks of white indicate that Elsa's ice has frozen Anna's heart. They appear after the accidental strike and grow until Anna is restored by an act of true love.
